The Forty Niners

In the year of 1848 a man that goes by James W. Marshall founded gold at Coloma, California. The information about gold traveled the United States slowly at first and then quickly picked and ended up being heard all around the world, which caused many people to start flocking over to California to find gold. This event is known as the Gold Rush, within those hundreds of thousands people coming over to find gold there was a group of people known as the Forty Niners. They were called the Forty Niners because they all started to heavily come to California in the year 1849. They would arrive by the tens of thousands around every continent and many different sailing and overland routes.

The life of a Forty Niner was rough for many and good for others. On days a miner could dig \$2000 of gold a day but on average they would be lucky to find 10\$ a day. When time past most easy gold was all found and some made it rich and then again the majority would be lucky to make enough to eat. Not to mention thousands of these miners died on the journey to California or during their diggers. Due to so many people finding gold it drove the prices up on everything to make the average cost of living much more expensive such as if a miner made 6 to 10 dollars a day, food and supplies would surpass that amount every easily.

Their camping and housing life styles were very horrible living situations compared to others during this time. Most lived in tents and cooked their food over open fires; these meals mainly were beans, bacon, or some local game they caught. Due to all the tents and few wooden buildings, fires would catch and burn down their whole camps and towns. Their winters were awful with heavy rain and snow, which made it hard to mine, along with caused many diseases.

Most of these miners left their families at home, which caused many to become home sick. The way miners contacted back to their families was by letters which was a long time for them to receive and then their was the few that would go into small cities on the way and use telegraphs to communicate with others. They would meet up with other miners and form friendships and small communities to travel with. When they needed to pass time they would play many different card games, gamble and bet on things for fun. Not to mention they also sometimes drink a bottle of whiskey and use humor, resiliency and sometimes despair to escape from their realities that surround them. Also these miners would learn new information and news from local Newspapers.

5 Needs

Friendships/Get Away from Reality/Contact with Families

The miners tried to create a semblance of community out of life while living in the mines. During the gold rush many miners left their families, so they need friendships and games/gambling to help them get away from the harsh reality of their journey to California to find gold. These games mainly consisted of card games along with some other ways of betting. These miners would also enjoy drinking whiskey to help them get away from reality. Sometimes they would have miner dances as well. They also tried to keep in touch with their families with writing many letters to them, but with transportation being slow it could take up to a few months for one side to receive a letter.

Mining Tools/Supplies/Money&Gold/Maps

The main thing miners needed were their supplies to do their job of trying to find gold. Some of tools would be basic such as shovel, pick, rope, saw, axe, wheelbarrow, knife and a gun, but they would also need things like large pans or Long Toms which are like cradles, which would help swish out the dirty and leave bigger particles to help find the gold easier. They also needed money or to find gold because with so many finding gold it made the cost of living rise exponentially, so if a average person found 6 to 10\$ of gold, their food cost and other supply cost would surpass that very easily, such as mining pans were 4 to 8 dollars, beef per pound was 40 to 75 cents and wagon was 40 to 80\$ so from that you can see the living cost were quite high. If they had maps or communication with other small miner communities/camps it would help them all find gold so they can live more suitable lifestyle.

Health/Clothing/Shelter/Food

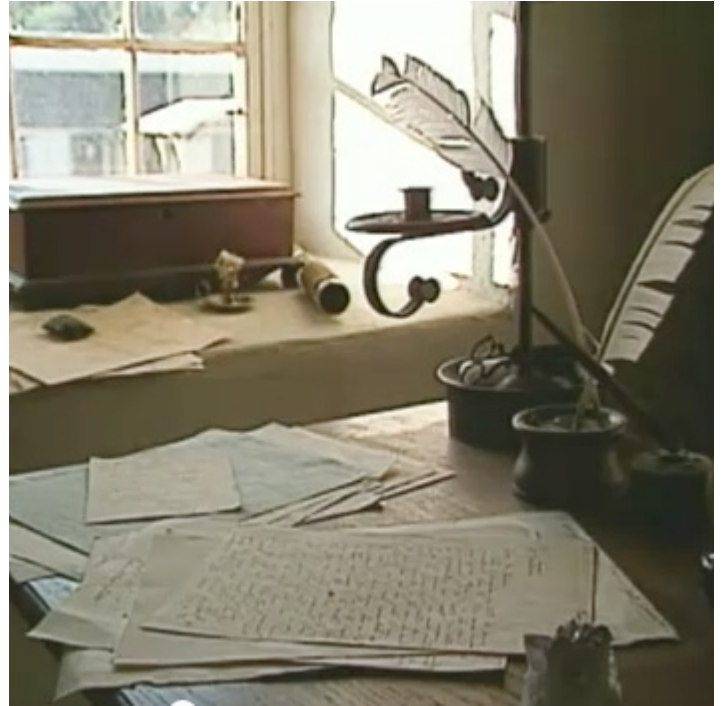
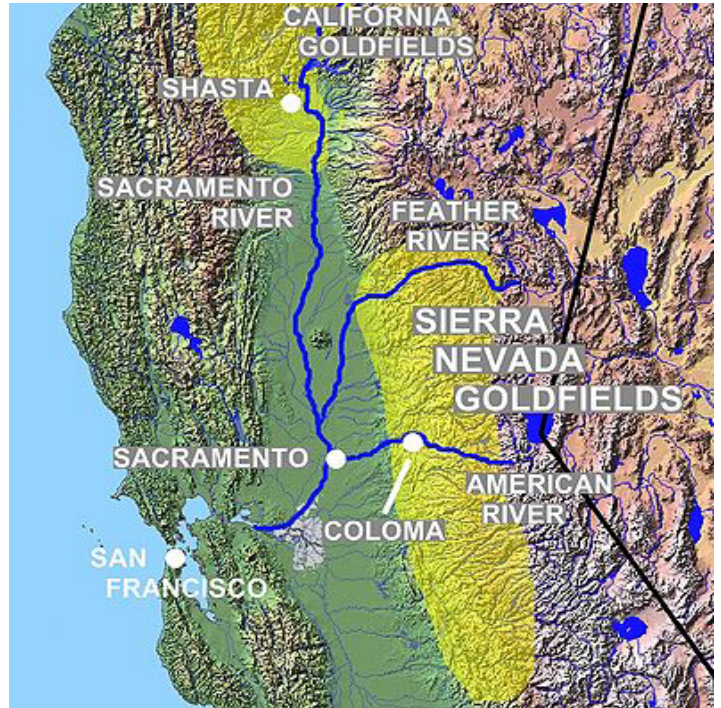
There were many hardships of traveling across the country; the journey alone was hard on their bodies and horses for those who traveled by land. Many of the miners didn't even make the trip and died along the way mainly by disease. This opened a harsh reality to the miners, mostly bad food and illness and sometimes-even death. They mainly lived in tents and few lived in logged cabins. So during the heavy rains and snow during the winter months it caused more illnesses to come up. So if they had a doctor with them or access to communicate with them it could eliminate fewer deaths of the miners.

Transportation

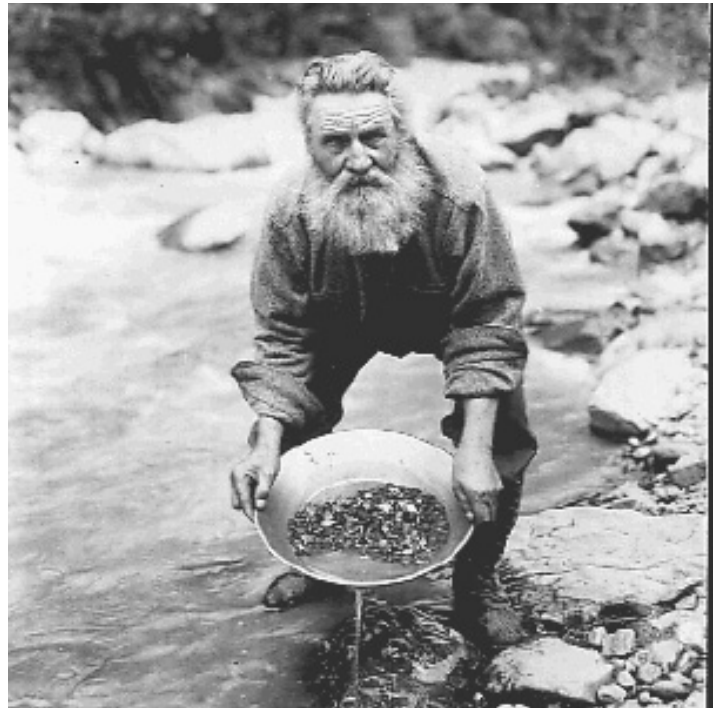

With some of the miners quitting mining and starting to open little businesses it helps out all the miners acquire their needs.



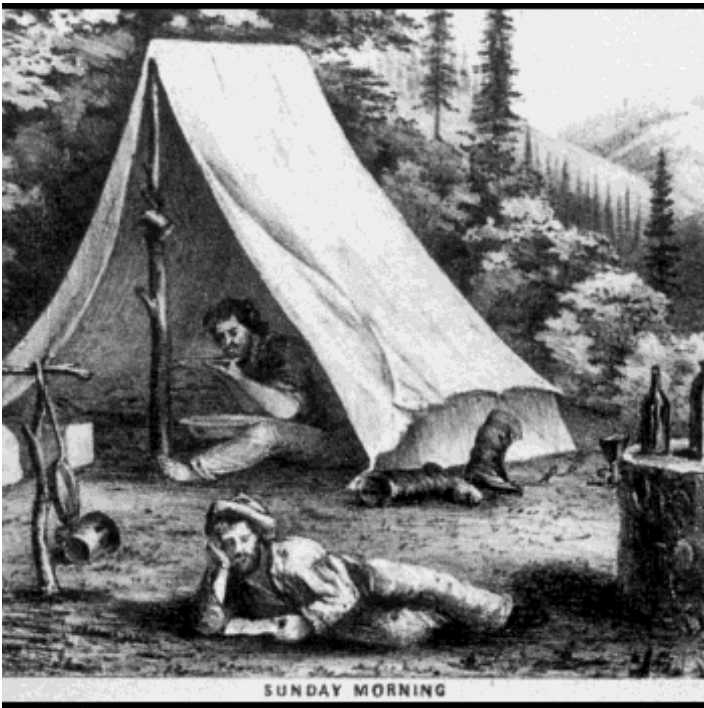
